## TREE AND PLANT LIST

### An Choill Bheag

#### Canopy – Shrub – Climbing – Ground – Leaf Litter – Underground Layer

The tree and plant species may vary and will be chosen according to being:

- 🌿 Appropriate to site and soil
- 🌿 Availability from native nursery stock
- 🌿 Saplings (young bare-root trees 60-90cms height) easy to transport and plant in winter months

### 1 Tree Species List:

#### Canopy Layer:

Alder, Birch, Oak, Scots Pine, Willow, Yew

#### Understory/ Shrub Layer:

Blackthorn, Crab Apple, Elder, Guelder Rose, Holly, Hazel, Hawthorn, Rowan, Spindle, Wild Cherry

### 2 Sourcing Trees:

**See list below:** Ask where the seed has been collected from – some will be native Irish and some will be from abroad.

**Make a tree nursery.** Collect and grow them from seed. This will take another 1-2 years for the trees to be ready to be planted, but is the most sustainable and educational way to do it!

### 3 Ground Layer:

Alpine Strawberry, Bluebells (Native), Bugle,  
Ferns (there are many species), Foxgloves,  
Ground Ivy, Ivy, Lesser Celendine, Lords and Ladies,  
Primroses, Periwinkle (Vinca minor),  
Self Heal, Sorrels, Tri-cornered Leeks,  
Water Avens, Wild Garlic, Wind Flowers (Wood Anemone), Wood Avens, Wood Sorrel (Oxalis), Snowdrops and many more.....

### 4 Climbing Layer:

Honeysuckle, Ivy, Wild Roses
