GLOBE Observer Phone App (create a free account)



An **isolated** tree taller than **4 meters** (3 stacked people)



You must be able to walk right up to the tree





## **HOW TO MEASURE YOUR TREE**



7 to 25 meters / 25 to 75 feet

- 1 Open the GLOBE Observer App and click on Trees
- Use the app to measure the angle between the bottom and the top of the tree
- 3 Photograph the tree (optional)
- Count the number of steps to walk to the tree (to estimate the distance), and make a measurement of the location at the tree's base
- 5 Submit your observation to NASA
